7. Housekeeping @ Brookwood RV Resort (\$15.00/hr.)

Clean bathhouses, cabins, the pool area for guests.

<u>REQUIREMENTS</u>: work clothes (casual, no tank tops), training provided, reliable transportation

HOURS: part-time (20-30 hours/week)

31. Clerk @ Essex County (\$ TBD)

The work involves responsibility for performing routine clerical work and/or assists in performing more difficult and responsible clerical work. The work is primarily of a routine nature and involves the performance of standardized clerical tasks. Although detailed instructions are given for new or difficult assignments and procedures are rather definitely fixed, employees must exercise independent judgment in applying them to specific cases. The work is reviewed by immediate observation, by checking completed work, by periodic or spot checks, by cross checking, or by another step in the clerical process. The employee does related work as required.
